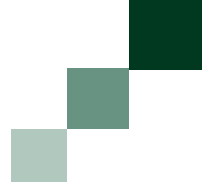

Congratulations to our students and staff who raised 3495 LE for the Foster House Charity this week. It was delightful to see the children throw themselves into their costumes.

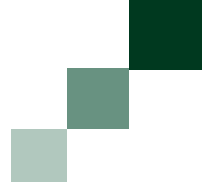


Malvern College UK Visit Monday 7th and Tuesday 9th November

Uniform Shop

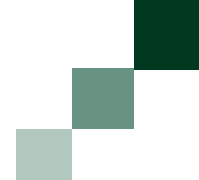
The Uniform Shop is open on Sunday and Thursday: from 8:30 – 12:30
